Prelude

Welcome

Call to Worship (John 1:10-14)

Christ was in the world, and the world came into being through Christ;

Yet the world did not know Christ.

But to all who received Christ, who believed in his name,

Christ gave power to become children of God,

Who were born, not of blood or of the will of the flesh,
